1.- BASIC INFORMATION ON DATA PROTECTION.

Who is responsible for the processing of your data? The companies Pagantis, S.A.U. and Pagamastarde, S.L.U.

What do we use your data for? To send you information relating to the consumer financing and payment services offered respectively by Pagamastarde, S.L.U and Pagantis, S.A.U. and, where appropriate, to manage and execute the financing and payment services contract for the Virtual POS. Also, to manage the sending of own commercial communications and similar including by electronic means.

With what legitimizing basis do we process your data? Consent, performance of the contract, legitimate interest and legal obligations.

Who do we give your data to? Your data is not passed on to any third party.

What are your rights? The right of access, correction, deletion and others as explained in the additional information below.

What do we do with your data? We use the information you have provided for the following main purposes:

- In order to **manage and execute your request for information** on the consumer financing and payment services offered by us and thus be able to offer your customers the possibility of deferred financing for purchases made in your own shops.

In addition, other purposes for which we process your data are as follows:

- To **manage and execute the financing and payment** service requested by you, consisting of offering financing to your own buyers or clients who purchase a good or service (hereinafter, "the Purchase") through your establishment, for the payment of the Purchases of said clients under the payment deferral method and, if applicable, making use of the Virtual POS.
- To send you **commercial communications**, including by electronic means, regarding our own financial products and services and similar, those that are responsible for processing that may be of interest to you and related to those that you have already contracted or, if applicable, those that you have had with us in the past.
- For the **prevention of fraud and money laundering** by requesting information and personal data concerning you and, in particular, your financial, employment and professional activities and situation.

For how long do we keep your data? The data shall be kept for the duration of the contractual relationship and, after its termination, for the years necessary to comply with existing legal obligations. However, if deletion of the data is requested and appropriate, the data will be blocked in order to comply with existing legal obligations.

What is the legitimacy for the processing of your data? The legal basis for the primary processing of your data is your **consent** to receive the information requested by you in respect of consumer finance and payment services offered by us. Likewise, with respect to the rest of the purposes, the legal basis for the processing of your data is the following:

- For **management of the contract**, the legitimacy for the processing of your data is the execution of the referred contract concerning the financing service and the payment service requested by you to offer this financing to your customers and buyers who are interested in acquiring your products and/or goods in your establishment in a deferred way through our payment gateway.
- For sending our own **commercial communications and similar**, including by electronic means, the legitimacy for the processing of your data is the **legitimate interest** we have as financiers who offer payment solutions and consumer financing services, to keep you informed at all times of the financial products and services available to you and which may be of interest to you.
- For the prevention of fraud and money laundering, the legitimization of the processing of your data is a **legal obligation** applicable to those responsible for processing and is specified in Law 10/2010 of 28 April on the prevention of money laundering and the financing of terrorism and its implementing regulations (RD 304/2014).

Who do we give your data to? Your data is not passed on to any third party.

What are your rights when you provide us with your data? The rights you have from the moment you provide us with your data are the following:

- **Right to Information:** Everyone has the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not we are processing personal data concerning them.
- **Rights of Access, Correction and Deletion:** The persons concerned have the right of access to their personal data, as well as the right to request the correction of inaccurate data or, as the case may be, to request their deletion when, among other reasons, the data are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected.
- **Right of Limitation:** In certain circumstances, interested parties may request the limitation of the processing of their data, in which case we will only keep them for the exercise or defense of claims.
- **Right of Opposition:** Furthermore, in certain circumstances and on grounds relating to their particular situation, interested parties may object to the

processing of their data. We will stop processing the data, except for compelling legitimate reasons, or the exercise or defense of possible claims.

- **Right of Portability:** Similarly, the interested parties may request, if possible, the portability of their data to other service providers provided that they have previously been used or processed with their consent or because of the existence of a contract.
